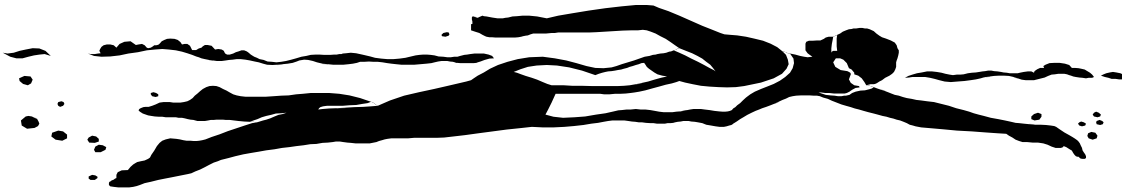


FOREST HILLS SWIM CLUB
